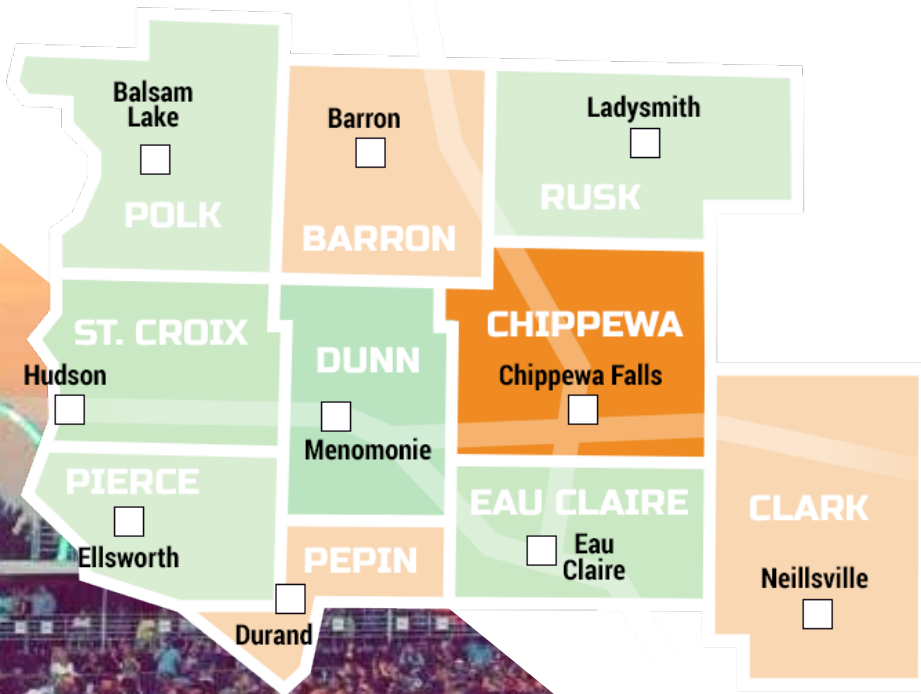


Work Where You Want to Live in Chippewa Falls, WI
